**W**e set the budget for fiscal 2017 (July 1, 2016-June 30, 2017). At \$516,325 our budget is up 5.4%. This will allow us to do more, especially in the social media area.

We hit many vitally important issues, both practical and theological. We discussed our publications, the possibility of restarting our school of theology (which will be considered again in January for a possible September 2017 restart), adding Ken Yates to the Board (starting in January) since Walt Millet is rotating off when his term expires at the end of the year, and reelecting Brad Daskocil and Jerry Pattillo as Chairman and Secretary-Treasurer, respectively.
