## Spanish Congregation NE Baptist Columbia, SC, August 5 (Ken Yates)

On Aug 5, I was asked to speak at the Spanish speaking church that meets at Northeast Baptist Church in Columbia, SC. The pastor had started a series on the book of Colossians and asked me to speak on part of Colossians 1. It gave me the opportunity to speak on the issue of the Judgment Seat of Christ in Col 1:22-23 as well as the importance of sound theology. The service was all in Spanish with no translation so it gave me an excellent opportunity to butcher the language. The



members of the church had never heard of the Judgment Seat of Christ as a place of rewards. While it is difficult to preach in Spanish, and I know I made many mistakes, the folks all said they understood what I said. I look forward to the opportunity to speak there again.

## More Ministry in Zambia (Ken Yates)

Last year I went to Zambia, Africa to teach a class on the doctrine of salvation. I was able to give them a copy of *The Gospel Under Siege* as part of the class. All the students speak English very well. My daughter Kathryn helped me with all the paperwork and slides.

The school asked me to come back and teach the next class the exact same thing. I was not able to go, but they said Kathryn could come back. She was able to go in August and give each student a copy of *The Free Grace Primer*. So this class got three books instead of one. The school has asked me to come back and teach

We approved a new budget that includes \$40,000 for radio. This has great potential to spread the Free Grace message.

Shawn has found about 10 stations that, while smaller stations, reach 500,000 to 1 million people each, and which only cost \$110 to \$150 a week for a daily 15 minute show. We are hoping we can tape a month's worth of shows in one day. That would cost around \$500. We are not sure how much it will cost to edit the shows into the proper length and format. Maybe another \$500 a month.

We will keep you posted about times and stations and startup date.
