

Old Testament Commentary Project in High Gear

GES partner Scott Sayre has done a great job recruiting editors and readers for the commentary as well as supervising the writers.

Scott, Ken Pierce, and I decided it would be best to publish the OT commentary in three volumes, following what is called the Tanakh, standing for Torah (Law), Neviim (the former and latter prophets), and Ketuvim (writings). Our aim is to have volume one, Torah (Genesis-Deuteronomy) in print by the May 2026 conference. Volume two, prophets, hopefully will be in print by December 2026. Volume three, writings, will hopefully be on hand at the May 2027 conference.

Ken Yates, Philippe Sterling, and I (Bob) start editing the Torah on the first of August. For the next year and a half, the three of us will devote a lot of time to this project. We should have the commentaries on Genesis through Deuteronomy ready for typesetting by end of the year.
